



**DIRECTORATE OF DEFENSE TRADE CONTROLS (DDTC) REGISTRATION:  
STATEMENT REGARDING COMPLIANCE WITH THE INTERNATIONAL  
TRAFFIC IN ARMS REGULATIONS (ITAR)**

The U.S. Department of State's Directorate of Defense Trade Controls (DDTC) administers the International Traffic in Arms Regulations (ITAR). The ITAR control exports of "defense articles and defense services." Nordson Corporation is registered with the DDTC. It is our corporate policy to be current with our DDTC registration, which is valid until 31 December each year.

Nordson maintains DDTC registration in order to test products manufactured by Nordson customers, which products may be subject to ITAR. Nordson manufactured products do not fall under DDTC jurisdiction and are therefore not listed on the U.S Munitions List. Further, Nordson does not render military defense-related services. All Nordson commodities, software, and technology are subject to U.S. Export Administration Regulations (EAR) 15 CFR Parts 730-774.

Nordson understands that technical data, hardware, or other tooling (e.g., documentation, software, drawings, and specifications) as defined and regulated by the ITAR (22 CFR Parts 120-130) and the EAR (15 CFR Parts 730-774) are subject to export control laws of the U.S. government.

We also understand that Nordson employees, agents or representatives may not transfer such technical data, hardware, or other tooling by any means to a foreign person, whether in the United States or another country, without prior written approval from the U.S. government. Additionally, Nordson employees who are foreign persons are not permitted to have access to any technical data, hardware or software without appropriate approval.
