

Nordson Corporation fully supports the efforts of the European Union to protect people from harmful substances. Nordson's Product Compliance Department oversees quality management systems and compliance at the highest level and our Product Compliance Council consists of representatives from each Nordson business unit as well as applicable corporate functions tasked with managing the program. The Nordson team is also working with our entire supply chain to ensure compliance from our suppliers, and to ensure continued compliance within each of our businesses. The Nordson Restricted Substance List currently includes substances listed in Directive 2011/65/EU and Amendment 2015/863/EU on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (RoHS 2), Regulation EC 1907/2007 on the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals (a.k.a. REACH), specifically the 240 substances of very high concern (SVHC) and proposed SVHC.

As of the issue date of this letter, we declare that to the best of our knowledge, Nordson Adhesives products manufactured in the U.S. facilities do not contain any of the 240 SVHCs (currently published as of 8-May-2024) in an amount exceeding the 0.1% (w/w) threshold specified in Article 33 of the REACH Regulation or in an amount exceeding the threshold limits (as of the date of this letter) except as noted below. Nordson Adhesives products do not include SVHCs in forms that can be ingested, inhaled, leak into the environment, nor do they represent a contact health hazard. However, in the instances below, we are aware of the potential existence of SVHCs at a limit that is above 0.1% of the weight of the individual part:

- Brass parts contained in the hydraulic and pneumatic circuits contain Lead no greater than 3%
- RoHS compliant electronic components in some cases exceed the SVHC limit of 0.1% of REACH
- RoHS compliant plastic components and PVC wire/cables in some cases contain fire retardant (Trixylyl Phosphate) in excess of 0.1% of REACH

Specific component information can be made available upon request. Under normal operating conditions, Nordson Adhesives products are not designed to- or anticipated to release any regulated SVHC substances. Nordson Adhesives did not conduct individual chemical analyses on components to determine specific content. We rely on our material suppliers for declarations, certifications, and/or available MSDS regarding the chemical composition of their components. Nordson Adhesives make no warranties, express nor implied, and assumes no liability related to any use of this information.
